Permissions and restrictions



Permissions – Movement

- * Mandatory cloth masks
- * Screening: Public and workplaces
- * Hygiene and social distancing
- * Curfew: 2000 to 0500



Permissions - Wholesale and retail

- * Food, hygiene, cleaning, protective and baby care, stationery
- * Winter clothing, bedding and heating
- * Medical supplies
- * Fuel, coal, wood, gas and tobacco



Permissions - Wholesale and retail

- * Hardware supplies for qualified tradespersons:
emergency repairs for homes and essential services
- * Components for vehicles for essential workers
- * Chemicals, packaging and supply of L4 products



Permissions – Manufacturing

- * 100% - L4 products, and inputs and paper
- * 50% - stationary, cement and construction material
- * 50% - automotive manufacturing including components
- * 100% Petroleum smelters, refineries and furnaces
- * 50% - winter clothing, bedding and heating



Permissions – Manufacturing

- * 100% - input to essential services
- * Essential maintenance to prevent damage and to permit orderly shutdown
- * 20% - all other manufacturing



Permissions – Transport and Logistics

- * Cargo for domestic and neighbouring countries and prioritisation of essential goods
- * E-handling*
- * Limited public transport*
- * Subject to regulations, directions and curfew

Permissions – Media

- * On-line services and live streaming
- * Newspapers and broadcasting
- * Productions for local broadcast



Permissions – Services: repairs and emergencies

- * Vehicle recovery services
- * Emergency car repairs
- * Emergency repair work including plumbers, electricians, glaziers and roof repairs, locksmiths



Permissions – Information and communications

- * All telecoms, information and comms technology
- * ICT equipment and airtime
- * Postal services and courier services for medical products and L4 services



Permissions – Agriculture, forestry and fishing

- * Food agriculture and services (livestock); export agriculture
- * Essential fishing operations
- * Essential harvesting and storage activities
- * Flori-culture and forestry



Permissions – Mining and quarrying

- * 100% coal production for ESKOM
- * 100% open cast mining
- * 50% other



Permissions – Electricity, gas and water

- * All electricity, gas and water supply



Permissions – Construction

- * Critical civil engineering and construction for public works projects, (including water, energy, sanitation, roads and bridges); critical maintenance and repairs.



Permissions – Accommodation and food services

- * Isolation, quarantine accommodation
- * Food delivery subject to curfew; no sit down or takeaway



Permissions – Domestic support

- * Live-in staff and support for L4 personnel



Permissions – Health and welfare

- * Trade union essential staff*
- * All social work, care and relief
- * Funeral and cremation services
- * Wildlife management
- * Veterinary and medical services
- * Sanitation, pest control, sewerage and rubbish removal
- * 50% recycling (paper, glass, metal) including informal traders
- * Subject to regulations, directions and curfew

Permissions – Finance and business

- * If possible, work from home
- * Supporting L4 services including car and equipment rental
- * Private security
- * Call centres*
- * Essential financial services*
- * Pay-roll related workers
- * Subject to regulations, directions and curfew
- * See full descriptions www.gov.za



Restrictions during L4

- * No local or inter-provincial travel except those operations returning to do or support L4; no international travel
- * No concerts, cinemas and gatherings
- * Limited exercise, no public gym*
- * No alcohol
- * No passenger air and sea travel
- * Subject to regulations, directions and curfew
